Living Worship to Bring Churches Across Milton Keynes Together for Major Worship Gathering at Christ the Cornerstone

Milton Keynes, UK – 21st September 2026

Christian friends Sarah Murrill and Jean Gowin are bringing churches and communities from across Milton Keynes together for what is set to be **one of the biggest worship gatherings ever held at Christ the Cornerstone Church.**

‘Still Waters’ will take place on **Thursday 26th November, from 7pm to 10pm**, and is being organised by Living Worship, a non-profit collaborative founded by Sarah and Jean following a shared vision to create opportunities for people and churches across Milton Keynes to come together and worship Jesus.

"We're passionate about bringing churches and communities together to worship Jesus. It really is that simple," says Sarah. "We're excited to be bringing a dedicated evening of live music, praise, worship and prayer to Milton Keynes, and we're praying that this will be a space where people can come just as they are and encounter God."

The November gathering will be open to everyone and will bring together people from different churches, denominations and backgrounds. The organisers hope to see Christians from across the city put aside church boundaries and gather together as one church to worship Jesus.

Jean says the vision for Living Worship began with a simple question:

"What if we created spaces where people could come together, put aside the busyness of everyday life and simply worship Jesus? We felt there was a real hunger for that, and Sarah and I wanted to respond to it."

The organisers believe there is something powerful about bringing people together across different churches and backgrounds. *"We really believe there is something powerful that happens when people from different churches come together with one heart and one purpose — to worship Jesus. This isn't about which church we belong to; it's about who we belong to. We want to create a space where the whole church in Milton Keynes can come together and lift the name of Jesus high,"* says Jean.

Living Worship is keen to connect with churches and Christian organisations across Milton Keynes who share a heart to see people and churches come together in worship. The team is inviting others to get involved in whatever way they can, whether through worship teams and musicians, prayer, practical support, promotion, volunteering, partnership or financial support.

"We would love to hear from churches and organisations who want to be part of what we're building," says Sarah. "There are so many people across Milton Keynes who are passionate about Jesus and about seeing our city come together. We believe that when we work together, we can create something that reaches far beyond any one church or organisation."

The event is free, although tickets are required and places are limited. Living Worship also welcomes voluntary donations from those who would like to support its vision. "At the heart of everything we're doing is a desire to create space for people to meet with God, worship Jesus and leave changed by His presence," says Sarah. "We're inviting everyone across Milton Keynes to come, bring a friend and be part of something bigger than any one church."
